EPLO celebrates 18 Years of Milestone Achievements at the Roman Agora

On Thursday, June 19, 2025, the European Public Law Organization (EPLO) celebrated the 18th anniversary as an International Organization with a distinguished cultural commemorative event held at the historic Roman Agora in Athens. The event brought together prominent figures from Greece, Italy, and the international diplomatic community to honor nearly two decades of the EPLO's commitment to the promotion of public law and governance.
